

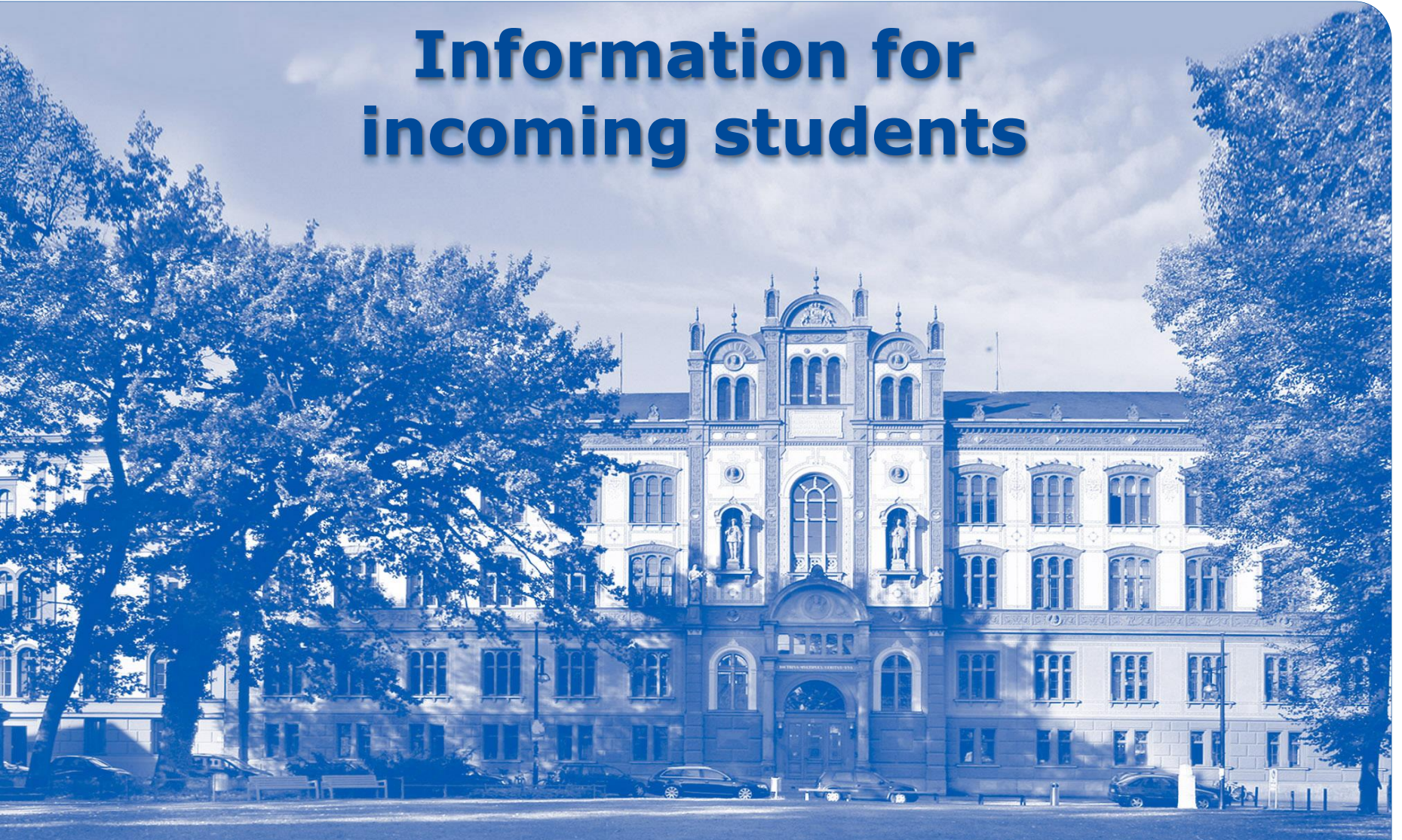

- **A good command of English (B2)**
 - This means that a student can...
 - ✓ understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in their field of specialization.
 - ✓ interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party.
 - ✓ produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

This lecture complements the "Grundkurs" English Linguistics. It introduces students to the study of language and familiarizes them with the core areas and key concepts of Linguistics, outlining major approaches to the field and specific methods and research tools that enable us to analyze human language in general and English in particular from both a system and a speaker-oriented point of view. The material will be presented in a way that helps participants to develop their analytical skills and engage in active learning.

<p>Credit points can be allotted to students for the successful completion of just one course component in modules comprised of 2 course components in the following cases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – 2 equally valued course components within 1 semester or over the course of 2 semesters – a Proseminar/Hauptseminar (an introductory or advanced seminar) + a Vorlesung (lecture) 	<p>3</p> <p>4 + 2</p>
<p>Credits points can be allotted to students for a failed module or a failed module component in which they have satisfied all other requirements (for example, regular attendance and the successful completion of tasks or assignments) in the following cases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – in the case of 1 partial component from 2 equally valued courses from a 1 or 2 semester-long module – in the case of modules that consist of a seminar and a lecture 	<p>2</p> <p>3 [= 2+1]</p>
